

## MEMBERSHIP ENQUIRIES – NON-ENTITLED

1. Due to restrictions by the SBA authorities, club membership is not currently open to “non-entitled” individuals (ie. civilians not connected with the base), although training courses are open to all.
2. Individuals having completed a course, or who already hold an RYA level-2 dinghy sailing certificate, may apply to sail with us on an ad hoc basis as non-members, on payment of daily sailing fees of €10pd or monthly sailing fees of €35pm. An application form must be completed.
3. Experienced / competent dinghy sailors without an RYA certificate may be assessed by a senior instructor (by appointment), and issued with a certificate (on payment of a fee). To pursue this they should refer to Iris Burt ([training@dhekeliasailing.com](mailto:training@dhekeliasailing.com)).
4. Individuals who own their own dinghy may keep it at the club (subject to space availability) and participate in club sailing and racing.
5. Individuals who do not sail, but are willing to provide their services to the club on voluntary basis, either as rescue boat operators or to fulfil some other necessary service, may (subject to approval) join the club as Associate members.
