## **Joining Information – Powerboat Level 2**

**Directions:** DSSC is opposite the Dhekelia Sovereign base and adjacent to CESSAC and Lambros fish and chip restaurant.

Pass the southern (seaward) entrance to the base on your left heading towards the Power Station. After ~300 metres, take the right turn into Agincourt Lane. At the crossroads continue straight on and the Sailing club can be seen directly ahead of you with its car park on the right.

**What to bring** – we recommend two complete changes of clothing, this should include old rubber-soled trainers, shorts, a polo/T shirt and a sweater. A light spray top to keep out the wind may also be useful.. Towel and shower kit. [A passport size photo will be required before we can issue a certificate, please bring one with you.](#)

**Refreshments** – the bar/galley is available for hot and cold drinks and snacks from 1000 hrs on Saturday and Sunday.

**Course Content** - the timetable, content and objectives will be explained to you at the beginning of the course. You should however be aware that the timetable may be changed, or an additional day needed due to the weather or students progress, these changes will be explained to you by your instructor.

**Safety** – is of the highest importance and buoyancy aids are available and MUST be worn when in the boats and on the pontoons. There is no exception to this rule for anyone. All the boats have buoyancy compartments and cannot sink.

**Changing rooms and Hot showers** - are available.

## **RYA Powerboat Level 2**

### Course Content

The course will run over 2 consecutive days from 08.30 to 1600 approximately each day. The timetable, content and objectives will be explained to you at the beginning of the course. You should however be aware that the timetable may be changed, or an additional day needed due to the weather or students' progress, these changes will be explained to you by your instructor.

### Safety

Is of the highest importance and buoyancy aids are available and **MUST** be worn when in the boats and on the pontoons. There is no exception to this rule for anyone.

### Instructors

All the instructors hold a valid RYA qualification, and the club is a recognized RYA Training Establishment which operates under the guidance of a Principal and Chief Instructor who also hold appropriate qualifications.

### Course Fees

Euro180 for entitled personnel and members, Euro 230 for non-entitled is payable at the beginning of the course, no cash, no course, no exceptions is the club rule. The fees include the appropriate certificates and RYA log and training books.

### What you will be able to do at the end of your course

Prepare the boat for sea, launch and recover it  
Be aware of local hazards and dangers  
Be able to secure the boat to a buoy and pontoon  
Know the advantages of differing types of anchors and anchoring in appropriate places  
Leaving and coming alongside correctly  
Controlling the boat safely and accurately at high speed  
Recover a Man Overboard  
Manoeuvre the boat in a confined space  
Be aware of balance, trim and weight consideration  
Understand the appropriate theory that supports the practical boat handling including Tides, Currents, Weather and Coastal Passage making  
Use the VHF Radio correctly to make boat/shore and boat/boat communications  
Understand Charts, Symbols and Collision Regulation

Our overall aim is to teach safe and correct boat handling and seamanship in powerboats.

This is a RYA level 2 powerboat courses after which you can apply for the **RYA ICC** ([International Certificate of Competence\\*](#)) which is a legal requirement to helm a boat of up to 10m in length in many countries outside the UK. (however Cyprus is not one of these!) In Cyprus you then must sit a test for a licence to drive in Cyprus waters!
