Joining Information – Level 2 Sailing Course

What to bring – we recommend a complete change of clothes that should include old rubber-soled trainers, shorts, a polo/T shirt and a sweater, a pair of sailing gloves A light spray top to keep out the wind may also be useful. Posing gear in not required at any time. Shower kit.

Refreshments – the bar/galley is available for hot and cold drinks and Burgers will be available at lunch time.

Course Content - The course will run from Monday to Thursday, with a provision for Friday if a day is lost due to weather, from 09:00 sharp until 17:00 approximately each day. The timetable, content and objectives will be explained to you at the beginning of the course. You should however be aware that the timetable may be changed or an additional day needed due to the weather or students progress, these changes will be explained to you by your instructor.

Safety – is of the highest importance and buoyancy aids are available and **MUST** be worn when in the boats and on the pontoons. There is no exception to this rule for anyone. All the boats have buoyancy compartments and cannot sink.

Hot showers - are available and most students use these at the end of each days training before the final briefing or lecture.

Instructors- all the instructors hold a valid RYA qualification or are experienced sailors operating under the supervision of a senior instructor. The club is a recognized RYA Training Establishment and operates under the guidance of a Principal and Chief Instructor who also hold appropriate qualifications.

Course Fees – are payable at the beginning of the course, no cash, no course, no exceptions is the club rule. The fees include the appropriate certificates and RYA log and training books.

Further Information – please contact the Principal – Alice Rook or the Chief Instructor – whose telephone numbers are displayed on the training notice board. Further information about the club is also available on the club web site.
